Parking Around the Island

Parking around Kawana Island is a hot agenda item for the KIRA team with residents and businesses raising concerns around long term parking and safety for all. KIRA continues to represent the community concerns with council.

KIRA have been advised of a few changes that residents should be aware of:

Council will soon introduce a 4-hour timed parking restriction 9am to 5pm, seven days a week in the Double Bay Park vicinity of Grand Parade.

Both sides of Grand Parade from Grenada Way roundabout to the roundabout at St Kitts will be timed parking the hours and days specified above.

A works order to mark yellow lines and a white continuous centre line on the bend in Grand Parade has also been sent to Council's Civil Operation team for scheduling. The purpose of this is prevent long term parking on areas of the road with poor visibility. We are waiting for an update from council of when this will take place and will update the community accordingly.



Island Fence Project

KIRA's work around the Island as part of the Fence Improvement Project will begin this month with the first pillar and fence being painted on the South East corner of Grand Parade and Sardinia Court.

Stay Safe on Grand Parade: A Friendly Reminder for Our Community

If you're one of the many who drive along the northern section of Grand Parade near Tarawa Street, here's a little reminder to keep things safe and smooth for everyone.

This stretch of road gets pretty busy, with around 450 cars passing through each day. With parked caravans and trailers making things tricky—especially around those bends where the road curves—it's important to stay sharp. The afternoon sun doesn't help either, sometimes turning those parked vehicles into serious blind spots.

And it's not just drivers who need to be careful. Our local wildlife, especially the scrub turkeys, tend to hang out near the trees on the side of the street. Unfortunately, they're often the victims of these visibility issues. No one wants to accidentally hit one of these birds, so let's all do our part to protect them.

Here's what we can do to keep things safe:

Stick to the speed limit. The 50 km/h limit isn't just a suggestion – it's the law. Especially as you approach those bends, slowing down can make all the difference.

Be mindful of the type of vehicle you are parking, along with the duration of which the vehicle has been parked.

If you've got a caravan or trailer that's sitting around unused, please consider moving it to a nearby storage unit such as:

National Storage Kawana - 2 Technology Drive, Warana

Kennards Self Storage - 51 Premier Circuit, Warana

Storage Direct - 96 Bellflower Rd, Sippy Downs

Look out for each other. Being considerate of other drivers goes a long way. A little caution and patience can keep everyone safe on the road.

FREE TREES FROM YOUR RATES!

Did you know that Sunshine Coast ratepayers are eligible to collect two free trees twice a year – that's four trees a year from the Council nursery.

The only conditions are that you need to present a current rate notice and collect the trees on Wednesdays between 1pm-3pm from Council's Caloundra Depot Nursery at 54 Industrial Avenue.

Sunshine Coast Council provides a selection of small, medium and large trees including specific species native to the area. So pop on down to the nursery and get planting today!.

KIRA meets every six weeks to address local island issues, arrange community events and create a sense of belonging on the Island.

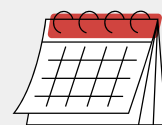
